## 1- Day Beginners Appliqué Workshop

This workshop will introduce you to some new appliqué techniques. Learn this “Off the Block” prepared edge, with freezer paper templates and starch-turned edges. Even beginners get excellent results with this hand appliqué method. No appliqué experience is necessary, but basic quilt making skills are assumed. As this class will feature all hand work, no sewing machines will be needed. Techniques that will be demonstrated include: working with Appliqué Template paper (freezer paper); Appliqué Pressing Tool & Stiletto; making perfect circles; 1/8” inch bias stems; multiple unit templates; concave and convex shapes; inside points; reverse applique; stitching; and more... There are no time demands placed on students. Get ready for a fun appliqué experience!

### Supplies

- Appliqué Pressing Tool & Stiletto
- Small Craft Iron – (I work with 2 or 3 irons)
- I use Cheri’s Cool Tool, Clover Wedge Iron & the Clover Mini Iron II
- Ironing Mat - such as June Taylor Cut N’ Press
- Spray Starch & Small Container with lid
- Stencil Brush 1/4” or aqua brush
- Appliqué Template Paper (freezer paper)
- Black & Red Identia Pen or fine point Sharpies
- Curved paper scissors – (I use the Fiskars Curved scissors)
- Fabric Scissors - small
- Clear Teflon pressing sheet or parchment paper
- Roxanne’s Glue Baste It
- Straight short Pins (appliqué pins work best)
- Electrical cord & power bar for your irons.

**\*\*\* Very Important \*\*\***

Everyone must bring their own tools  
No sharing!

### Design Board

To build your design board, begin with ¼” Foam Core Board, cut to 25” x 13”. Do not cover with fabric. To keep edges clean, cover with blue painters tape.

### Pattern/Fabric Requirements

**Pattern** - A line drawing pattern and pre-printed freezer paper sheets will be provided (no tracing required). You will need to bring freezer paper/applique template paper—at least 4 sheets.

**Fabric** - fat quarters will work for this class. Bring your favorite Spring colors—and don’t forget to bring a green for leaves and vines.

**FOR BEGINNER CLASS** – you will need a medium and small iron. The Clover Wedge Iron or a travel iron and the Clover Mini Iron I or II.
