

## The Feather Princesses 2023 Quilt Show Entry Guidelines

- 1. Person entering quilts must be a current member of **The Feather Princesses** (at the time of the show).
- 2. All entries must be constructed and quilted by the person(s) named on the entry form.
- 3. Quilts must be a single unit. No rods, wood, or metal framing is accepted.
- 4. All entries must have at least 60% appliqué—hand, machine, or fused (must be sewn).
- 5. All entries must be quilted by hand or machine through all three layers.
- 6. Tied quilts are not allowed.
- 7. Quilt panels are not allowed.
- 8. A **DUET** is defined as two or more people working together on a quilt.
- 9. A *GROUP* is defined as three or more people working together on a quilt.
- 10. A completed *Quilt Entry Form* (filled in and signed) must be submitted for each quilt entry no later than **Wednesday, January 11, 2023**.
- 11. *Quilt Entry Forms* must be completed in full, along with a color picture of the quilt. Any forms that are not completed will be returned to entrant.
- 12. All quilts must be turned in on **Wednesday, February 8, 2023**, inside a pillowcase. Please write your name, address and phone number on the pillowcase [in permanent marker]. Sleeves are not required. No entries will be accepted after this date under any circumstances.
- 13. All quilts must arrive clean, undamaged, and free of odors. **The Feather Princesses, Inc.** reserves the right to not display an entry if the quality or condition does not meet the criteria.
- 14. All deadlines are final.
- 15. Late entries cannot be accepted.
