## August Fat Quarter Exchange

At our fun-filled and joyous birthday party this coming Wednesday, we will exchange blue, pink, and white fat quarters—"blue and white" to commemorate our Porcelain Anniversary and "pink" to salute our distinguished Feather Princesses Appliqué Guild.

According to our trusted online authority, Google:

- The color blue represents both the sky and the sea and it is associated with open spaces, freedom, intuition, imagination, inspiration, and sensitivity. Blue also represents meanings of depth, trust, loyalty, sincerity, wisdom, confidence, stability, faith, and intelligence.
- Pink is a light red hue and it is typically associated with love and romance. It is often described as a feminine color, perhaps due to associations people form during early childhood. "Girls' toys" are usually pink and purple, while "boys' toys" are often red, yellow, green, or blue."
- White is the lightest color and it is achromatic (having no hue). It is the color of objects such as snow, chalk, and milk, and is the opposite of black. White objects fully reflect and scatter all of the visible wave lengths of light.

Speaking of porcelain, it is a ceramic material made by heating raw materials, generally including kaolinite, in a kiln to temperatures between 1,200 and 1,400 °C (2,200 and 2,600 °F). The manufacturing process used for porcelain is similar to that used for earthenware and stoneware, the two other main types of pottery, although it can be more challenging to produce. It has usually been regarded as the most prestigious type of pottery due to its delicacy, strength, and high degree of whiteness. It is frequently both glazed and decorated.

According to Southern Living," Porcelain is more expensive than regular china because making porcelain truly is an art form. Devising the mix of kaolin and other ingredients, shaping a plate to a delicate edge or sculpting a figurine, glazing it, firing it, and creating a gorgeous, nearly translucent, durable piece is incredibly difficult.

# Creative Appliqué Quilt Group

We have not yet established a regular meeting date; but, our next meeting will convene on Friday, September 1, 2023.

We will weave multiple colors together to create an interesting background, as shown in my sample; and I will bring this sample to show at our August 9 guild meeting.



The materials list is based on my sample. You will create a piece that is approximately 20" x 21". At our September 1 meeting, you will need to bring two sets of fabrics:

- The first set is the vertical set of fabrics. I used 4 different fabrics from light to dark as shown on my next sample.
- Fabric requirements for the vertical pieces, also light to dark:
  - 3 fabrics 6" x 40"
  - if using fat quarters 12" x 20"
  - 1 fabric (center fabric) 3" x 40" or 6" x 20"
- Fabric requirements for the horizontal pieces (5 fabrics total)
  - 4 fabrics 6" x 40" or If using fat quarters (12" x 20")
  - 1 fabric (center fabric) 3" x 40" or if using fat quarters (6" x 20")
- You will also need a piece for backing, a little bit larger than the finished piece, 22" x 22". This can be cotton, no stick interfacing, something you can fuse your weavings onto.
