As with just about everything else in life these days, there is quite a variety of yummy fruit flavors to mix with lemonade to quench our thirst.

"Chillin' With My Gnomies" Christmas Gnome Special Block

If you've been out shopping at the stores lately, you probably noticed that Gnomes are really "hot" right now. There are Summer Gnomes. Autumn Gnomes, Garden Gnomes, Patriotic Gnomes, and more! And then there's our favorite,



the ever-popular Christmas Gnomes.

Last year at our 2022 Christmas Luncheon, we distributed a Christmas Gnome Special Block kit, "Chilling' With My Gnomies" to most of you. And we hope you learned and had fun as you created your special block. If you have already finished your adorable Christmas Gnome Special Block, we congratulate you! If you have not started creating your block, then we lovingly suggest that you take out your Christmas Gnome Special Block kit now, design and appliqué your "Chilling' With My Gnomies" block, and bring it to our upcoming Christmas in July **Celebration**, convening at our July 12 guild meeting.

Please remember:

- If you received a kit and now prefer not to make the block, please return the kit to me, Princess Joanne **Rodriguez**, so we can share it with the lovely Princess who wins the completed Christmas Gnome blocks.
- As you create your block, please follow the easy instructions included in the kit to appliqué it.

Also please use the following supplies contained in the kit:

- White and silver snowflake (13" x 13") background fabric square.
 - The background fabric square measures 13" x 13," allowing enough fabric for a generous seam allowance, resulting in a 12¹/2" x 12¹/2" square block.
 - (12 inches for the appliqué design, plus ¹/₂-inch seam allowance on each side of the block, to be trimmed by the winner.)
- Black Christmas Gnome fabric, red/black check fabric, and green/black check fabric.

Also, remember:

- When you finish appliquéing your block, save your left-over fabric scraps, to share with the winner(s) of the blocks to use to finish their quilts, if they desire.
- To turn in your completed block and fabric scraps to me at our July 12 guild meeting. You must turn in your

completed block by July 12, to be eligible for the drawing.

- At our Feather Princesses July 12, 2023 guild meeting:
 - The drawing to win the blocks will be held at our "Christmas in July" Celebration.
 - We will display all of the completed blocks turned in, vote, and award a prize to the maker of the block that receives the most votes for the "Most Unique Appliqué Design."

Row By Row Experience 2023

Porcelain is a ceramic material made by heating raw materials, generally including kaolinite, in a kiln to temperatures between 1,200 and 1,400 °C (2,200 and 2,600 °F). The manufacturing process used for porcelain is similar to those used for earthenware and stoneware, the two other main types of pottery, although it can be more challenging to produce. It has usually been regarded as the most prestigious type of pottery due to its delicacy, strength, and high degree of whiteness. It is frequently both glazed and decorated.

According to Southern Living, "Porcelain is more expensive than regular china because making porcelain truly is an art form. Devising the mix of kaolin and other ingredients, shaping a plate to a delicate edge or sculpting a figurine, glazing it, firing it, and creating a gorgeous, nearly translucent, durable piece is incredibly difficult. So the next time your nana asks you to dust the Lladró, be careful—you're dusting a figurine that has roots going back 2,000 years."

Just like making porcelain, creating stunning appliqué quilts is truly an art form as well. We carefully design or purchase our patterns, select top-quality quilting fabrics and supplies, execute the appropriate techniques to get the desired results and appearance of our quilts. It's a detailed oriented process for sure, but worth every single moment of commitment, dedication, and time to create our cherished and stellar quilts.
