Tool Time - 2024 January Recap and February Announcement

To begin, let's recap the January 2024 Tool Time:

• The Cupcake Project –

Princess Janet Slee and I were sad that we did not win the cupcake blocks at our Feather Princesses 18th Anniversary Celebration back in August 2023. However, we came up with an alternative plan! We decided to make our own blocks in 2024 and use them to create table runners. Our plan would work this way... both of us would kit up 12 cupcake blocks. Each kit would contain two sets of six identical blocks. Then Janet gifted me with one set of six of her blocks; and I gifted Janet with one set of my six blocks. We will both have the same 12 blocks to appliqué; and we plan to stitch one block a month during our Feather Princesses guild meetings. Then by December, we'll have completed our 12th block. At that time, we'll be able to make our very own table runners. And we'll have a completed project for 2024!

- We shared an online site I had not previously seen. It is <u>www.stitchesoflovequilting.com</u>. On this site I found several appliqué Block of the Month programs:
 - Boo Crew
 - Christmas Lane
 - Loads of Fun (pickup truck with themed items in the truck bed)
 - Hop to It (Spring Theme)/Garden Moments/ Gnomes.

Stitches of Love Quilting also has thread kits and notions for sale. You also can find them on Facebook, Instagram, and You Tube in addition to their online site. Please enjoy perusing this wonderful site. I haven't purchased anything from this site, but it is fun and seems to have a lot of potential.

- During our January guild meeting, someone (I think it was Princess **B.J. Weber**) mentioned a site called <u>www.suzysstitch.com</u>. Of course, I had to look it up. It's another appliqué site filled with crafting projects and whimsical appliqué Block of the Month projects. Check it out and see what strikes your fancy. Suzy's blocks are free for one month. After that she charges a nominal fee for any blocks you missed.
- Princess **Karen Benitez** came up with a solution for cleaning her gummy needle, while stitching wool pieces fused with Wonder Under. She found an eye glass cleaning cloth and wiped the needle with it. Voila! Clean needle.

- Princess **Annette Kocsis** suggested cutting up one of the eye glass cleaning cloths and placing a piece of the cloth in each of our sewing kits!
- Another Princess mentioned using dryer sheets. And yet another lovely Princess suggested using alcohol to wipe the gummy needle clean.

All in all, we had a lively discussion once again with different thoughts. When we throw an idea out there for discussion, the Feather Princesses love to share their thoughts, ideas, and experiences. It makes a girl smile for sure.

Our February Tool Time will hold more sweet surprises. I will share a new "organization" idea that I discovered all by myself. I think you'll find it as interesting as I did... at least I hope so!!! - Two 8-inch square coordinating pieces of fabric, in the colors of your choice
- Threads to match
- Marking pen or pencil ٠
- Appliqué needle •
- Pins
- Small scissors used for trimming ٠

We will start by marking a heart design onto one of the 8" squares of fabric and then basting the two squares of fabric together. Next the fun will begin and the heart design will take shape, as we carefully cut-away, one by one, the different sections of the heart, and then turn under the seam allowances and hand stitch them down. We will continue this process until we cut-away the entire design and VOILA, the heart will be revealed! ==>

Spring Special Block

This Winter has been cool and totally fun; but Spring is prodding and quickly nudging at our doors. And in about five weeks, Spring will actually make its grand appearance, bringing chirping birds, swarming bees, budding and blooming flowers, and of course-showers, to be more exact April Showers, depending on where you live. And here in the United States, "April Showers Day" will fall this year on Monday, April 22.

Here in Florida, Spring is typically our dry season; and we don't always get much rain. But in other areas, rain is quite abundant during the months of Spring. In parts of the Northern Hemisphere, an April shower is rain during the month of April. One of the major causes of the often heavy downpours is the position of the jet stream. In early Spring, the jet stream starts to move northwards, allowing large depressions to bring strong winds and rain in from the Atlantic. The saying "April Showers" is traced back to England from the 1500's poet, Thomas Tusser. Back then, he wrote "Sweet April showers do bring Spring" May Flowers." In England, the month of April brings huge weather swings with the jet stream lifting northward at the start of Spring.

So, because we don't typically get many rain showers during the month of April here in sunny Florida, we Feather Princesses will just have to appliqué our own interpretation or version-with colorful umbrellas, rain boots, flowers, and more. What FUN that will be! So, be sure to pick up your "April Showers" Spring Special Block kit (at the bargain price of \$2 each) at our exciting February 14 guild meeting during our lunch break.

Our Executive Board is really thrilled to present this Spring Special Block to you, as we welcome Spring. So have fun stitching it, and then be sure to return your completed block at our June 12 guild meeting, when the drawing will be held—just in time for our 2024 Hurricane Season!

This easy and simple cut-away appliqué technique yields such beautiful and elegant results, especially with heart designs. But you may implement this technique with just about any shape that you desire. When you finish cutting away and stitching your fabric heart this coming Wednesday, you may use it as a block in a wallhanging, quilt, placemat, or table runner. Or you may use it to make a pillow, or on the front of a bag or purse. The possibilities are endless!

So, come and celebrate Valentine's Day, and find love with us at our February 14 guild meeting program, as we review this reverse appliqué technique and cut-away our hearts.
